Also went to the dealer for a while, and took a good look at a sedan there, (airknight has an avant)
EKTA and Elswain also checked.
Everything is just prepared, with a version with a fixed rear seat, so a folding bench can be placed.
Also, don't have to cut spot welding, like on the older A4s
I only need to buy 1 bracket a cover bracket 4 screws and a screw to secure the cover bracket.
(hinge point between the 1/3-2/3 part)
The metric wire in which the 4 screws must be on site, already simply tapped.
If I estimate it that way, what I spent on it today, there will be a folding 1/3-2/3 sofa in it within 30 minutes.

You will see 2 in the 1st photo in this post you will see all 3



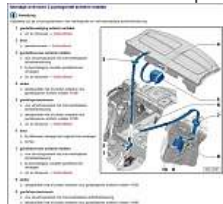

Fold down back seat 1/3-2/3 leather placed

Today replacing the fixed rear seat with the leather fold down rear seat (1/3 - 2/3).



encountered 1 problem, the tap wire for mounting the side panels was not present. There was a hole in the 9 mm airframe on the spot, there had to be an M6 bolt in it (so 2 pieces of M6 torx (N 908 163 01 -> €0.18)

Just visited the dealer, he popped you into a wire bus M6, didn't have to pay anything. They are looking with their eyes open, which I keep changing about the B8



Loosening backseat with 2x Torx 50
Removed the brackets that stuck the fixed rear seat with.
Because these protrude too much and so the handrail cannot go back far enough.
They were stuck with large doll nails, pierced.



I do miss a piece of carpet in those 3 places, but not annoying because the back seat is in front of it.

Placed the pivot point, part number is already mentioned in the topic, 4 socket bolts M8.
M8 wire was already present in the airframe.



Something I still have to do, or maybe I'll leave it that way, the middle belt, comes from the parcel shelf.
Convert a seatbelt to the 2/3 part of the rear seat, or a slot in the parcel shelf.
Maybe tap another parcel shelf on the head without a slot and then the belt automatic in the 2/3 part.
For clapping the sofa no problem, seat belt is long enough to fold completely.

Under a pin in the airframe, which comes at the bottom of the handrail, and above the stop



Leather middle arm support placed, simple.



Tested the electrically operated front seats, connected the plus and the minus via the battery charger, all motors worked.
Footwell lighting also worked.



Need to convert a bit more, it's an English set, advantage the driver's chair hasn't been used much.
But Normally there is a seat occupancy sensor in the passenger seat, which is now in the driver's seat, that has to change for a while

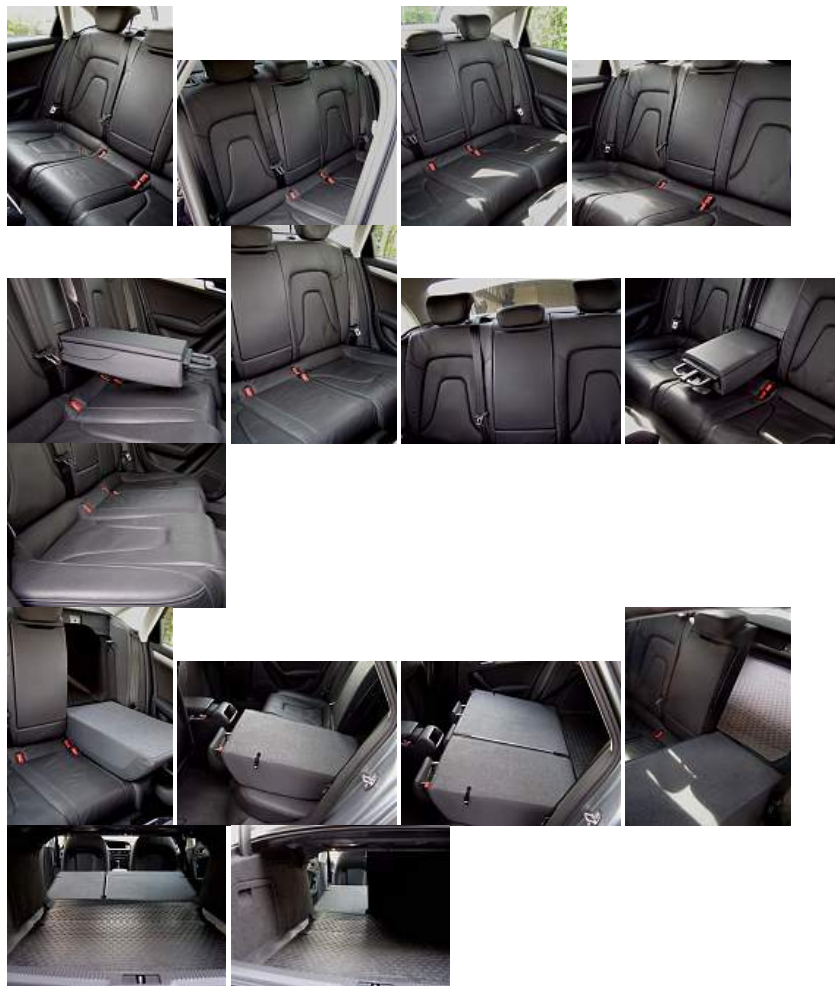
Also adjust the front door panels, because otherwise my wife is in control of the 4 windows and the mirrors
Swapping the handrails with my current chairs. Then stay put with a fake trunk opener on the right.
The English version had no alarm installation, so no fake alarm buttons on the right side later.

However, an LED at the top right of the panel, see if I can connect it, it will also flash when the B8 is locked.
Anyone experience with a telltale LED on the right ??

The clips for the roller blinds behind have been ordered, further making the wiring harnesses for the front seats.

And when installing the front seats, install the airbags of my seats.
